Dates

The Blender Artist Market is an outdoor event that will run from the 17th November 2017 - throughout summer.

The markets will run from 5pm-9pm.



History

The Blender Artist Market operated for the past 5 seasons at the old home of the Blender Studios in Franklin Street. Over the five summers, the markets have welcomed over 175,000 guests.

We are excited to re-launch the event in our new location in Docklands and will continue to open the studios to the public during the market.



Audience

The market attracts a broad diversity of guests and has something for everyone! Children, teens and adults alike will find activities and stalls that appeal to a wide variety of interests.

Below is our projections for the expected audience demographic:

- 35% local docklands residents
- 35% families with children from inner Melbourne regions
- 30% inner City workers (after work crowd)

We will have between 40 and 50 individual store holders per market. We are looking for vendors ranging across an array of products including fine art, craft, gifts, fashion, jewellery, treats, ethical & sustainable, fairtrade and more! The main thing is that it is handmade and preferably local artisan goods.

Getting There

DRIVE:

The District is conveniently located only five minutes from the CBD of Melbourne at the Docklands.

FREE TRAMS:

The City Circle free tram stops right outside The District Shopping Centre, Docklands Drive. Route 70 and 86 also stop directly outside the Centre (in the free tram zone).

TRAIN:

Take the train to Southern Cross Station and walk over the Bourke Street Pedestrian Bridge to Harbour Town Esplanade, then along Docklands Drive or the waterfront to The District.
